Let's get ready to RAAC 'n Roll!

WHO IS THE PRESENTER OF RAAC 'n ROLL?

Among her many accomplishments, Peggy Klump is a highly accomplished USEF licensed "R" dressage judge currently accepted into the "S" program for promotion, and a USDF Gold Medalist.

WHAT THE HECK IS RAAC 'n ROLL?

A unique educational program to help Adult Amateurs learn how to ride for their qualifying scores, and to help ALL competitors ride their tests more effectively by developing an "eye" for key pieces. RAAC 'n Roll actively involves both mounted demo riders and unmounted participants in identifying weaknesses in test riding skills and then showing how to make simple fixes to gain points.

WHEN IS THIS WONDERFUL RAAC 'n ROLL EVENT?

The program starts Friday, July 23, 2010, with a pizza dinner and unmounted interactive information-packed presentation on the basics. Then, on Saturday, July 24, 2010, there will be a whole day of practical application (with lunch provided), where demo riders practice the skills, and unmounted participants join the discussion and gain new insight from the view of the judge at "C"!

WHY DO I WANT TO RAAC 'n ROLL?

If you are planning on getting to the Regional Adult Amateur Competition (RAAC), this is an invaluable tool to help you get your qualifying scores. Or if you plan on doing any showing at all, whether junior, AA, or open, this program will help you build skills necessary to "fix" your problem areas and earn higher scores every time. Either way, this is an event not to be missed!

GUIDELINES for DEMO RIDERS:

The riding portion of the program will be demonstration rides at the highest test of the level which parallels the RAAC class. There will be two riders per level from Training through 3rd, with two riders for 4th levels and higher combined.

To ensure that both mounted and unmounted participants have a good learning experience, and that everyone is SAFE:

- The horses **MUST** be quiet, safe, cooperative, familiar and accepting of groups of people and chairs at C.
- The riders must have solid show experience at the level they are asked to ride.
- The riders **MUST** attend the Friday session, and are encouraged to attend and participate in sessions when not attending to their own horse.

Demo riders can be adult amateurs, trainers, or junior/young riders.

Selected riders must agree to present themselves and their horse in an appropriate manner. The rider will wear clean breeches and a clean, collared shirt. Half chaps and/or boots will be polished. A hard hat is required with long hair either pulled back or put up.

The horse will be clean and brushed. If appropriate for the breed, the mane will be short (braids are optional), legs clipped or neat, and if appropriate the whiskers and bridle path clipped. Tack will be clean. To enhance the visual clarity of unmounted participants, clean white polo wraps (preferred) or white horse boots will be worn.
