INLAND COMMUNITIES CHAPTER AWARDS:

- **Diane Prisco-Mink Perpetual Trophy:** Presented to the horse and rider combination with the highest average percentage at Training-4th levels. Rider must compete at all ICC rated shows for the current year.
- **Holy Smoke Award:** Presented to the horse and rider combination competing together for the first time ever at an ICC show who earn the highest average score at Training - 4th levels. Rider must compete at all rated and schooling shows for the current year. Rider must be an amateur or junior.
- **Junior High Point Trophy:** Presented to the horse and rider combination riding at Training-4th levels achieving the highest average score from 3 tests at 3 ICC shows (1 schooling and 2 recognized) during the current year. Rider must be a junior.
- **ICC Year End Highpoint Award:** Year End Highpoint Awards are offered at Training-4th levels. Riders must compete at all ICC shows to be eligible. The awards will be presented to the horse and rider combination with the highest average percentage obtained from their 3 best scores, providing the scores meet the following minimums:
 - Training Level: 60%
 - First Level: 58%
 - 2nd-4th Level: 55%
- **Rae Lockwood Memorial Trophy:** To the adult amateur horse and rider combination riding at Training-4th levels achieving the highest average score from 3 tests at 3 ICC shows (1 schooling & 2 recognized) during the current year.

SHOW RULES:

This dressage show is covered by all rules and specifications in the current USEF Rule Book. Any situation not covered by the USEF rules will be decided by the horse show management and such decisions are final. Entry blanks must be filled out completely with all signatures, membership numbers & copies of CDS cards, and fees. Incorrect and/or Incomplete forms will be charged a \$5.00 office fee. Please check that all class numbers are correct. For insurance purposes, any horse brought on the show grounds must pay a \$10.00 grounds fee. Any horse schooled in the warm-up area must instead pay a \$15.00 schooling fee. All children must be supervised at all times. Dogs must be on a leash. All riders are required to wear headgear when mounted. Failure to enter the area at the specified time will result in elimination. Times will be telephoned. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to call if times are not received. Please call Meg Hammond (909)327-8995 with any questions.

ENTRY AGREEMENT - ALL PROVISIONS APPLY

Owner/agent/participant agrees that show management is merely providing stabling for the convenience of the participant and that management, the sponsoring organizations and the facility shall have no responsibility whatsoever for any injury, loss, damage, etc., as a result of using said stabling. Owner/agent/participant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold all sponsoring and recognizing organizations, show management, their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers harmless from any loss, damage or claims as a result of said use. Owner/agent/participant assumes all care, custody, and control with regard to this use. Owner/agent/participant agrees that every horse entered or which they bring to the show grounds will be subject to the rules of the horse show management but that neither the horse show management nor any sponsoring organization will, in any case, be responsible for damages as a result of any loss, damage or claim that may occur. They agree to defend, indemnify and hold the horse show facility, horse show management, their directors, officers, officials and/or volunteers and affiliated organizations harmless therefrom.

I hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless USDF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities. I also hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless the show management, show committee and members, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.2.

FEDERATION RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION - This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition **ICC SCHOOLING DRESSAGE SHOW, PEPPER GLEN FARM** to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR318 and EV113, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that the "Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.
