I agree to release and hold harmless the competition, CDS, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, USEF and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, right of misappropriation.

### Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition ICcCds Early Summer Rated Show to the following:

I AGREE that USEF, CDS and the "Competition" as used herein includes the Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, lessee, owner, agent, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death.

I AGREE to hold harmless and release USEF, CDS and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

### Qualifying Scores

- Basic-3 scores from 2 different judges Intro C, 65% or higher Novice only
- Training through Intermediare 1-3 scores from 2 different judges 60% or higher

### Two Adult Amateur Divisions

- Elite-Competed previously in a CDS Championship Show.
- Novice Never competed in a CDS Championship.

### Great Prizes

- 1st and 2nd place neck ribbons -embroidered cooler (1st) halter (2nd) bridle ribbons 3rd – 10th place.
- High Percentage Elite and Novice Rider – bridle ribbons to each division.
- ROSES Award-neck ribbons division for the High Percentage Elite and Novice Rider 50 years of age and older who officially sign-up for the division prior to their RAAC ride. Three divisions: Basic through First; Second through Fourth; and FEI.

### Other Details

- Amateur Riders must be CDS current members, have a USEF Amateur Card and be 22 years of age or older.
- The horse owner must be a current member of CDS.
- Competitors will ride once at the highest test of the level.
- Amateurs who qualify MAY compete in ONLY ONE Regional Competition.
- Scores earned at the CDS Championship will NOT count towards qualification.
- \$25.00 fee per horse and rider team for each level.

### Qualifying Dates

- Opens Aug 28, 2023 at any show with CDS recognition.
- Closes: 12 days prior to the first competition day of the regional show entered.

# CDS JR/YR CHAMPIONSHIPS ~ SOUTH AND NORTH

## Ways to Qualify and Participate in CDS JR/YR Championships



Rider and Owner must be a current CDS members when scores are earned



Rider must be 21 Years of Age or under



Scores must be earned at a CDS Recognized Shows from 8/28, 2023 - 12 days before Championship.



Rider must pay \$25 Nomination Fee at least 12 days before the championships.



**SCORES:** A horse/rider combination must achieve the following for qualification at the various levels for the CDS JR/YR Championships.

Introductory AB	3 scores of 60% or better with 2 different judges
Training Level	3 scores of 62% or better with 2 different judges
First Level	3 scores of 60% or better with 2 different judges
Second Level	3 scores of 57% or better with 2 different judges
Third Level	3 scores of 57% or better with 2 different judges
Fourth Level	3 scores of 57% or better with 2 different judges
FEI JR/YR Levels	3 scores of 57% or better with 2 different judges
FEI Children	3 scores of 57% or better with 2 different judges
FEI Pony	3 scores of 57% or better with 2 different judges

Previous JR/YR Champion and Reserve winners may not compete at the JR/YR Championship at the same level with the same horse at Training or First Level.

For purposes of competition in the Dressage Division: Individuals are eligible as Juniors until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Individuals are eligible as Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21.

The Championship classes will be the two highest tests of the level and Intro A and B. The Champion will be the horse and rider combination that achieves the highest combined percentage in those two tests. Honor Rounds are mandatory and require that the horse and rider appear in appropriate attire. The new Introductory Level is limited to 13 and under and may not cross enter any other classes.

### EXTRAS

**CDS TEAM COMPETITION:** to be held at the CDS JR/YR Championship Shows. They will be held at Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth and FEI Levels. There are no pre-qualification requirements for the CDS Team Competition except that the rider must be a member of CDS.

**EXTEND THE CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE:** There is a new Championship Division designed especially for those who have qualified to enter the Junior/Young Rider Championship Classes, designed to help competitors prepare for any Championships that they may enter in the future. Championship Competition computation will be 60% (dressage tests average), 20% (freestyle), 5% (jog skills), 15% (team theory). Rider will also be judged on in-hand jog skills and will participate in a Theory test.

In addition to the Individual Championship classes and the Team Competitions, **LEADLINE for 8 and under**, open classes, pas de deux, freestyle and quadrille are offered. There is no prior qualification for these classes, other than the standard freestyle requirements. Juniors and Young. When the show is recognized by USEF/USDF, GreatAmericanInsurance Qualifying classes will be offered.
